To whom it may concern.

My name is Dr. med. Rolandas Dagilaitis. I am a member of the Lithuanian Society of Vascular Surgery, the Baltic Society of Phlebology (co-founder and board member in 2009-2018), and the International Union of Phlebology.

I have had in-service training at the International Academy of Laser Medicine (Florence), and at the Dr. Maurins vein center (Riga). My knowledge and expertise in this space was further enhanced at many scientific conferences worldwide as lecturer or participant.

Currently I am a Vascular surgeon at the "Northway medical center" and specialize in the diagnostics and treatment of venous system diseases and aesthetic phlebology.

I started performing endovenous laser treatment in 2007. Since that time, I have performed more than 4000 successful laser operations, and currently have wide and significant experience with different types of endovenous lasers (980nm, 1470nm, 1940nm) and different types of fibers (bare, radial one ring, two ring and infinite in regular or slim modifications).

In 2020 I started to use the neoV1940 system at 1940nm and since starting, I have completed 422 procedures with it. I have found patients to declare of less pain than my previous experience with 1470nm systems and found the closure rate of the 1940nm system to be close to 100% (0 failures from 422 patients), including follow up times of more than 1 year.

When comparing the neoV1940 system to all my previous experience with 1470nm machines, I find this 1940 machine to be at least as effective as the 1470 machines for vein closure, and with benefits in terms of enhanced safety and less side effects.

Accordingly, I can declare the neoV1940 to be safe and effective for vein occlusion and would highly recommend it as a first line treatment option for vascular surgery.
